STIPULATION FOR COURT COMMISSIONER TO ACT AS TEMPORARY JUDGE	CASE NUMBER:

The judicial officer in this court, _____, is a Superior Court Commissioner. Commissioners are full time judicial officers appointed by the judges of the Superior Court. Before this Commissioner can hear or preside over this case, all parties must agree that this Commissioner can be the judge for this case. This stipulation is an agreement to the appointment of the above named Commissioner as a Temporary Judge for this contested domestic violence restraining order hearing.

Each person signing this stipulation understands that the pending case has been assigned to the above named Commissioner, who is a member of the State Bar of California. Further, it is understood that this Commissioner has been appointed as a Temporary Judge pursuant to an order of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court and has taken the oath of office as to all matters assigned [California Constitution, Article 6, Section 21; Code of Civil Procedure section 259, subdivision (d)].

It is stipulated by the parties signing below that the above named Commissioner, sitting as a Temporary Judge, shall hear and decide the contested domestic violence restraining order matter currently pending in this case.
