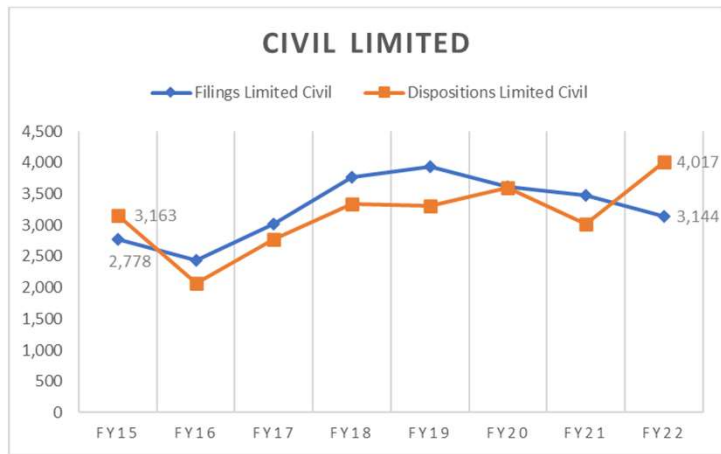

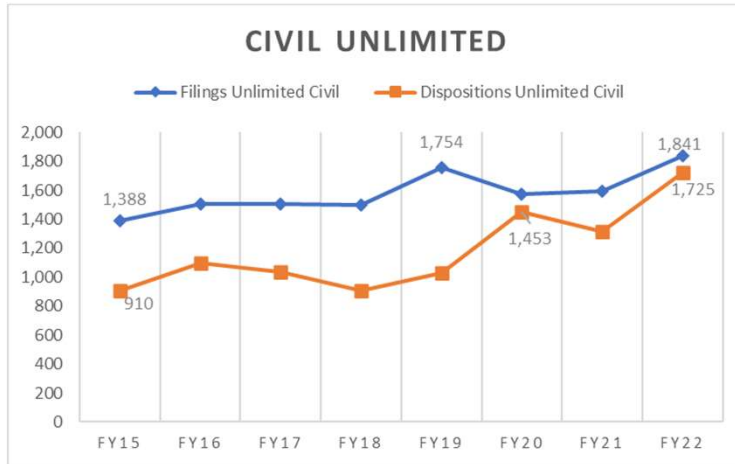

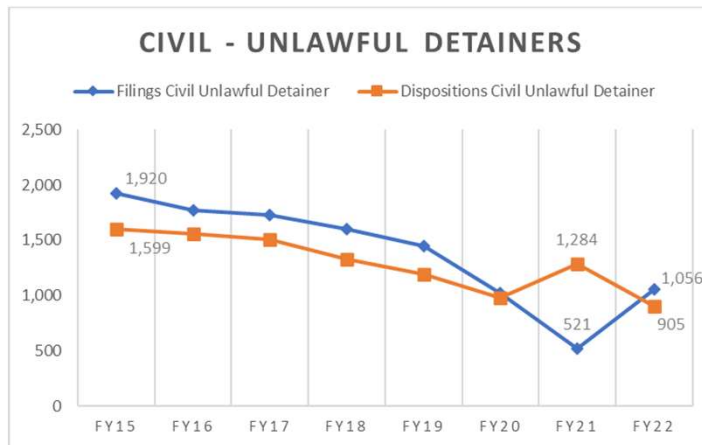

# Civil - Unlawful Detainers



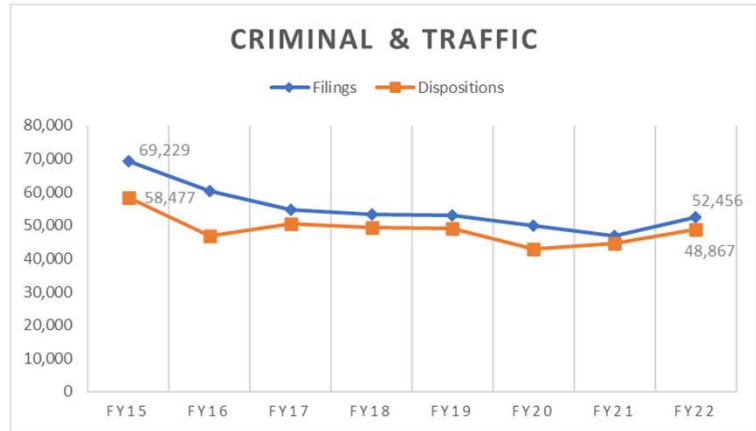

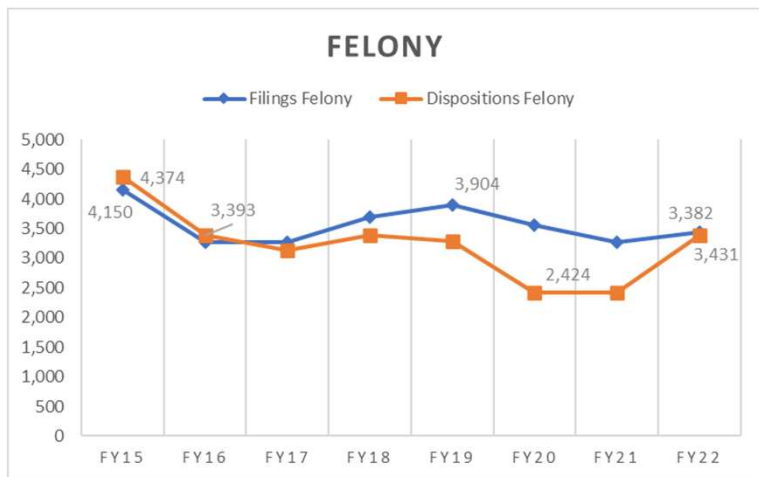

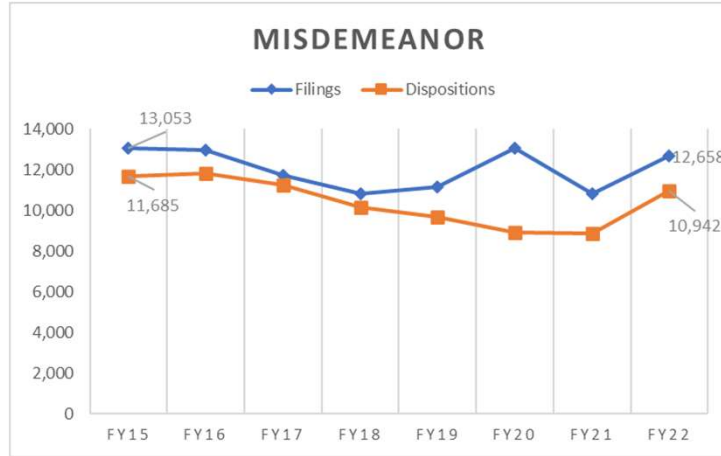

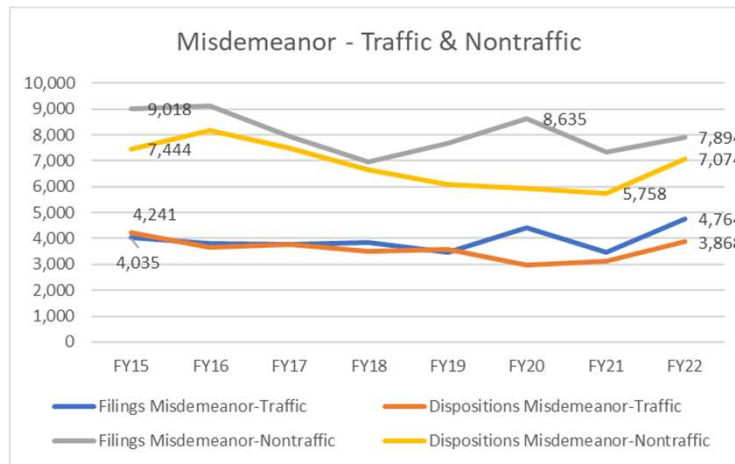

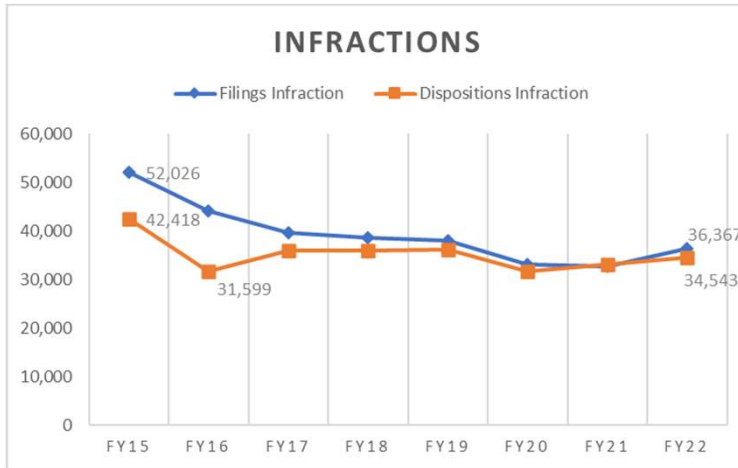

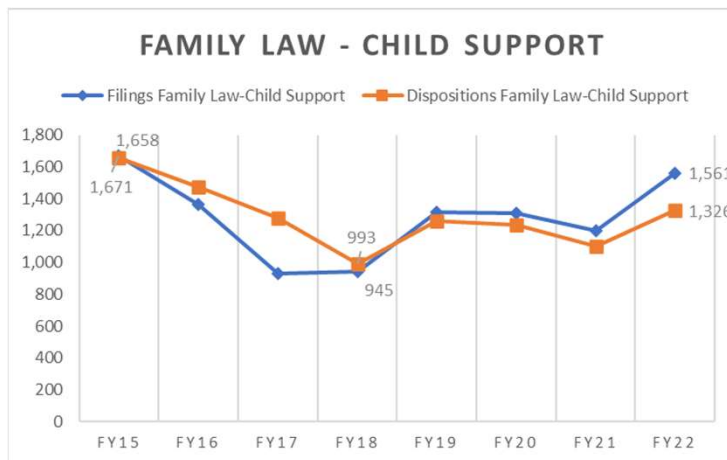

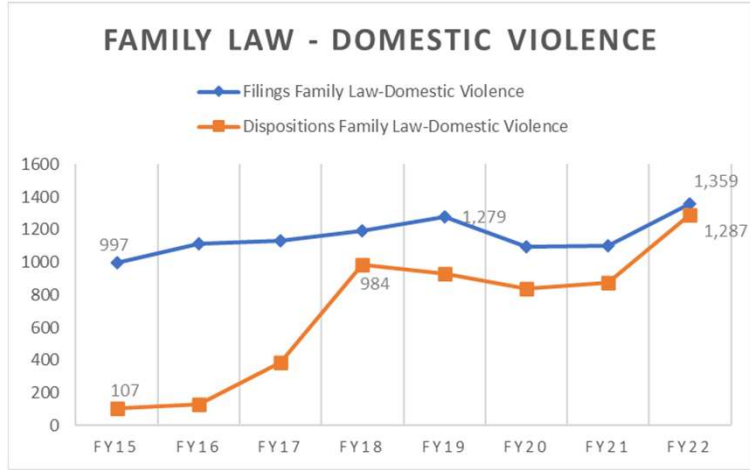

# Family Law – Domestic Violence

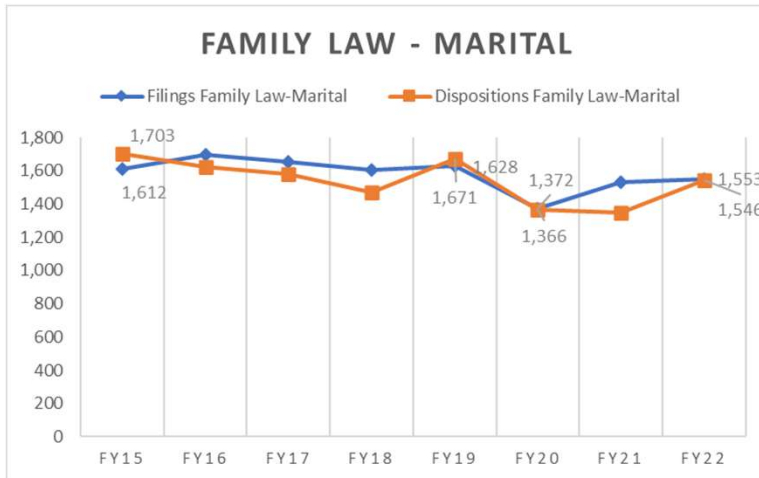

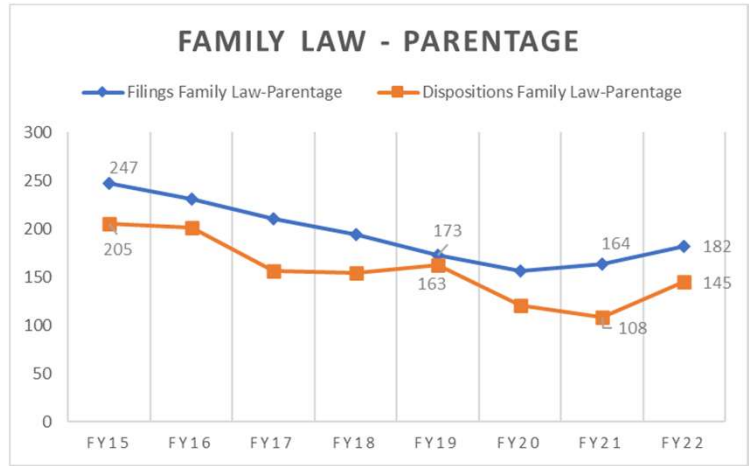

# Family Law – Parentage

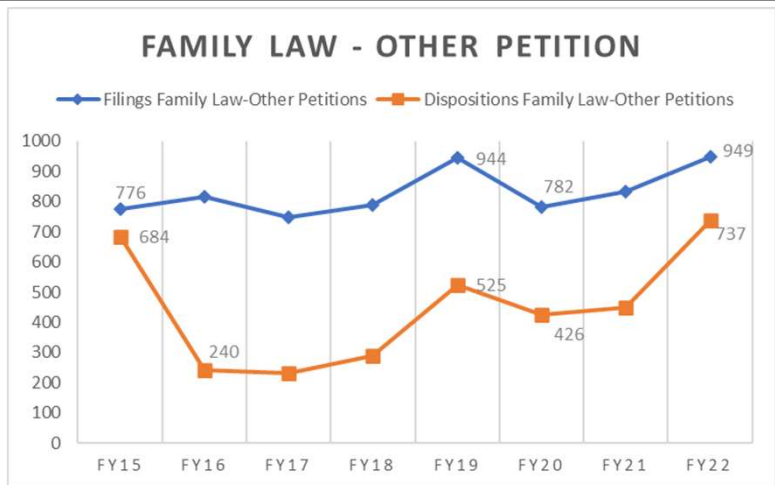

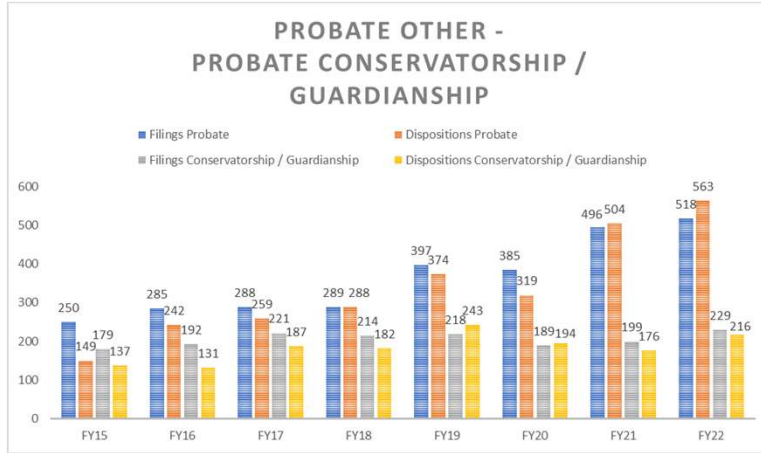

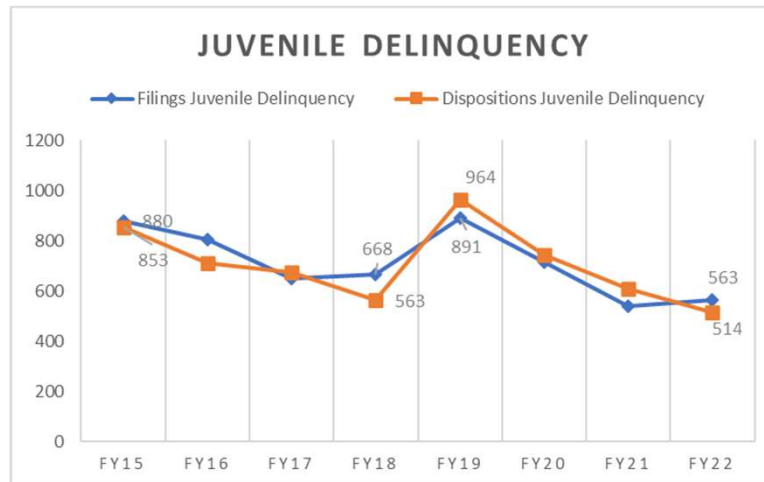

# Juvenile Delinquency

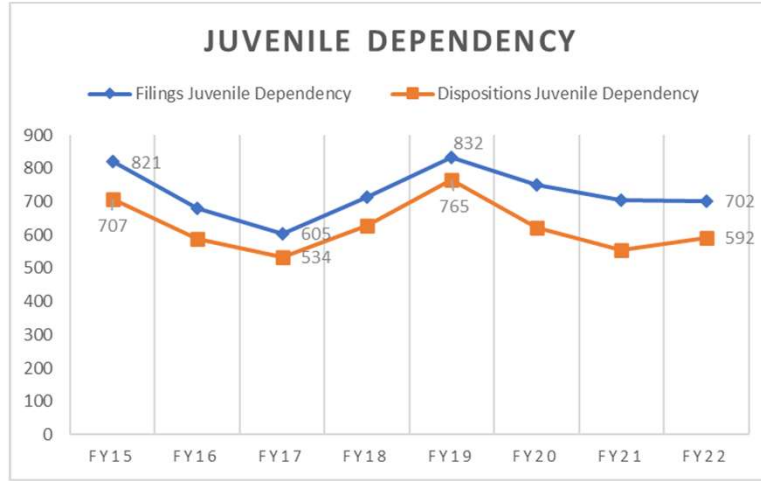

# Juvenile Dependency

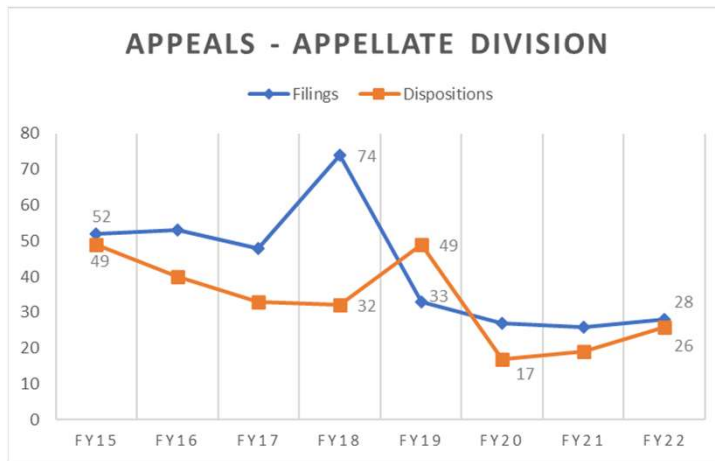

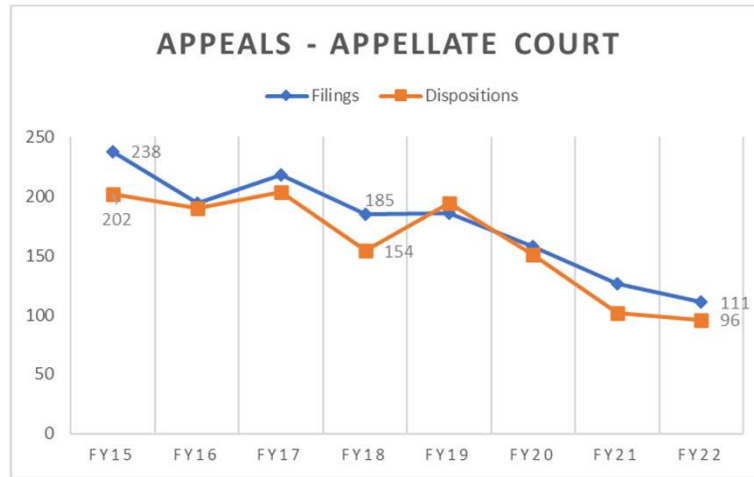

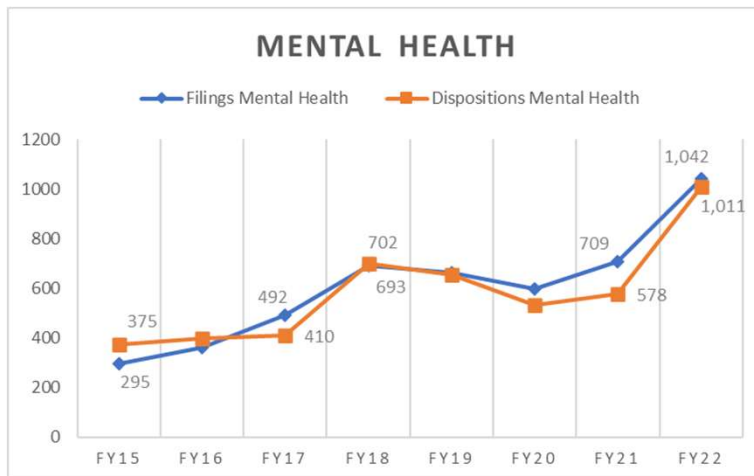

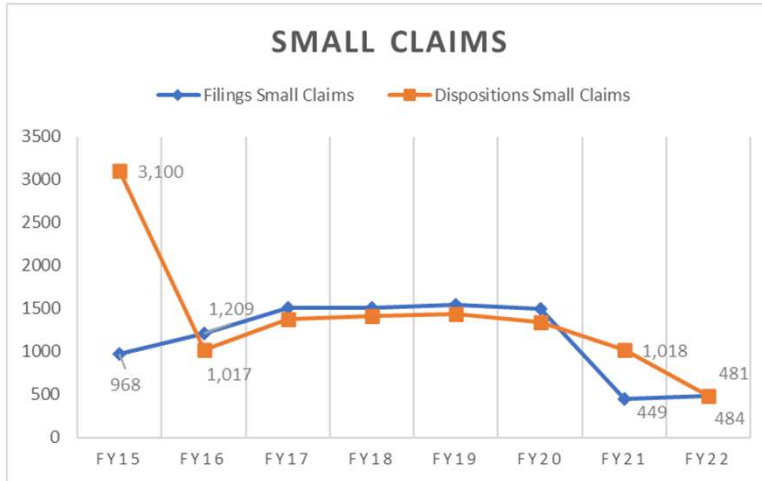

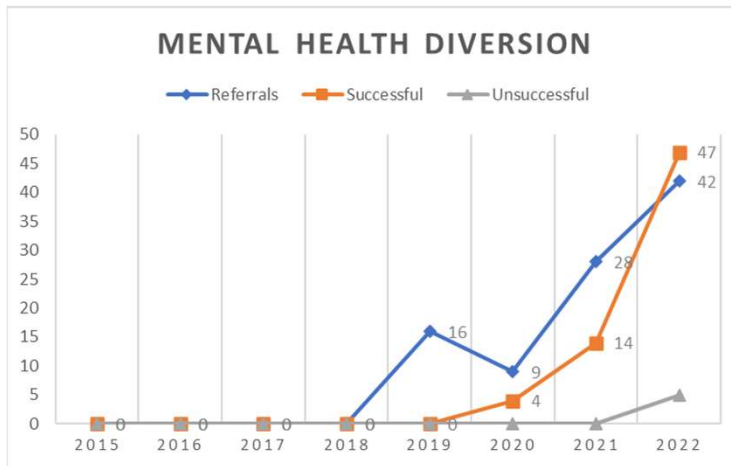

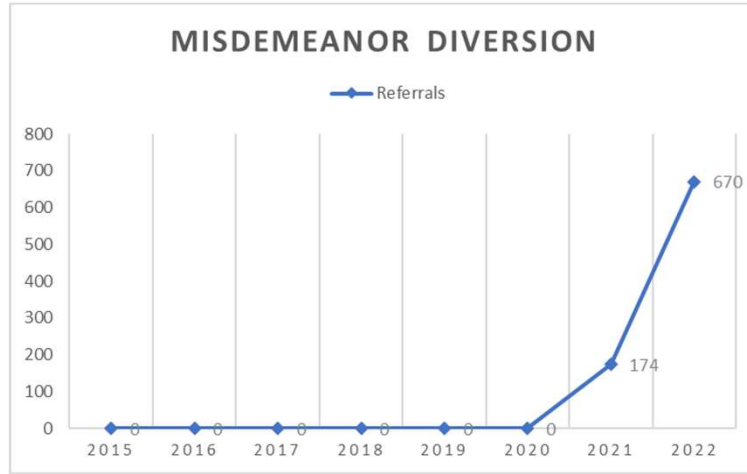

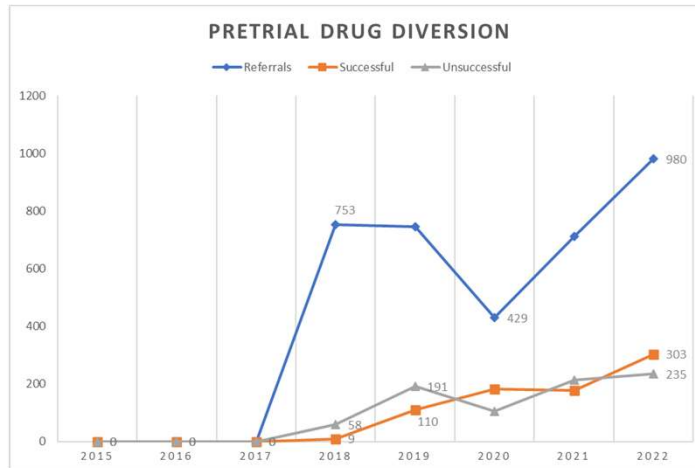

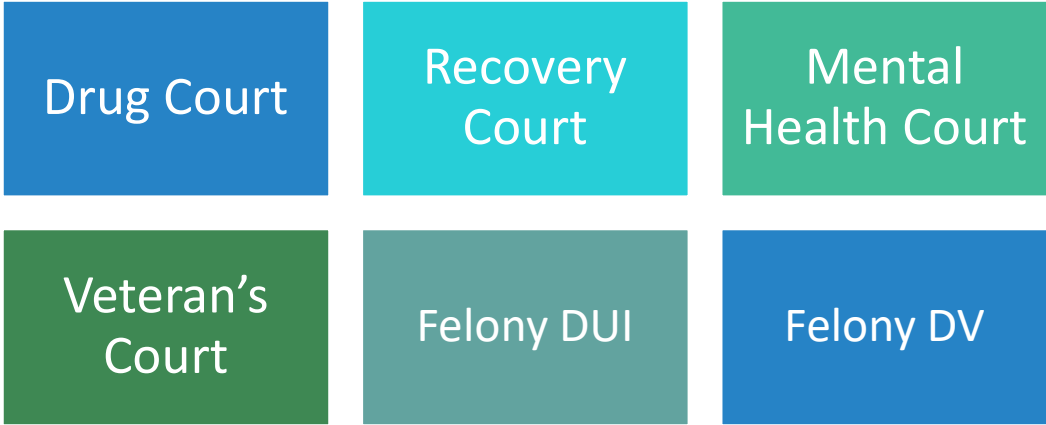

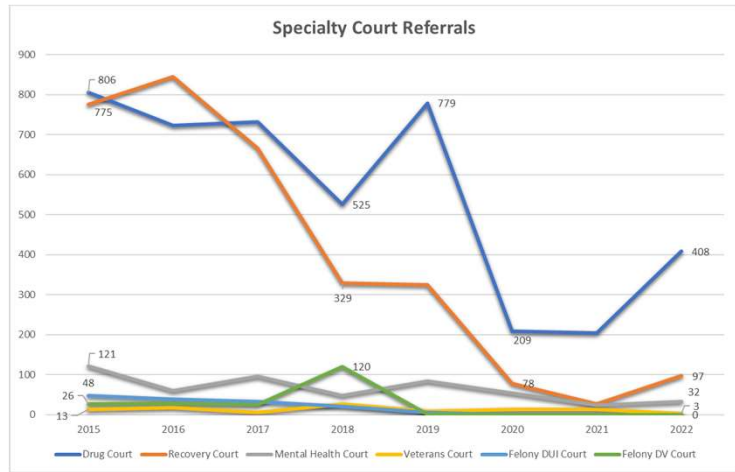

# Found Mentally Incompetent

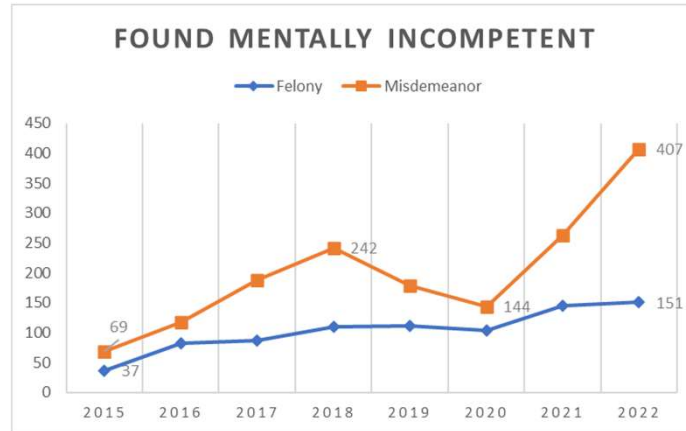


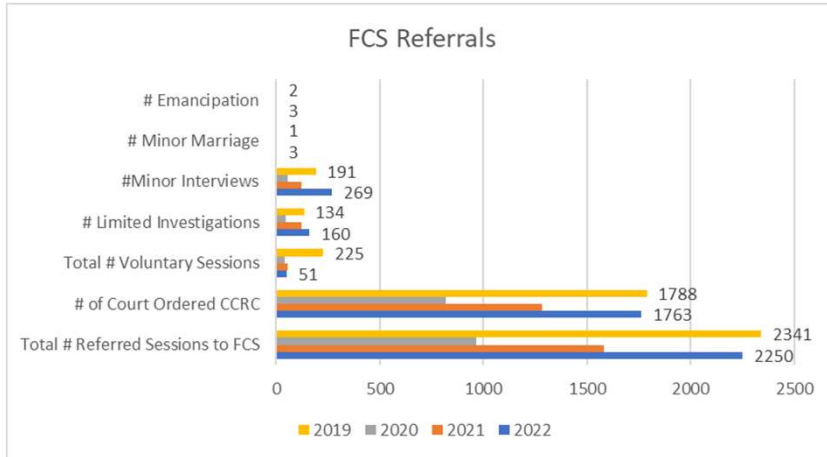
Chart reflects the number of Incompetent to Stand Trial referrals for both Misdemeanor and Felony cases

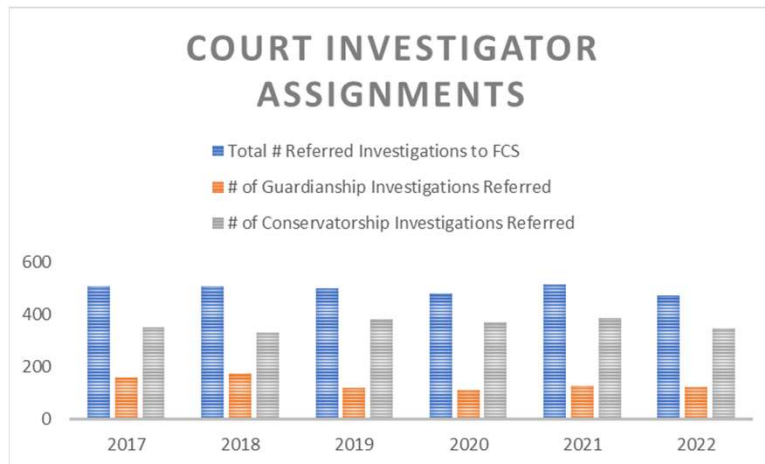

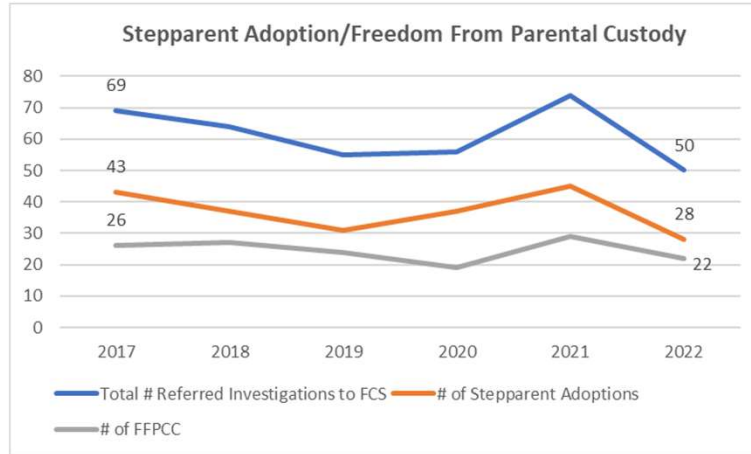

Walk-In - Total In-Person minus Workshop total

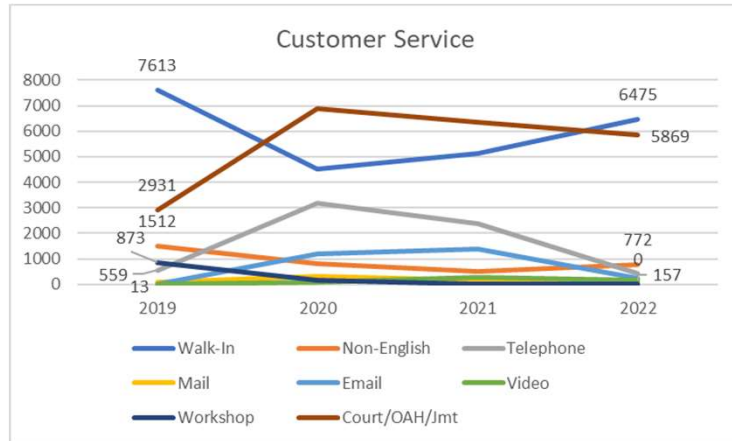
Walk In during COVID months = drop offs in person for review

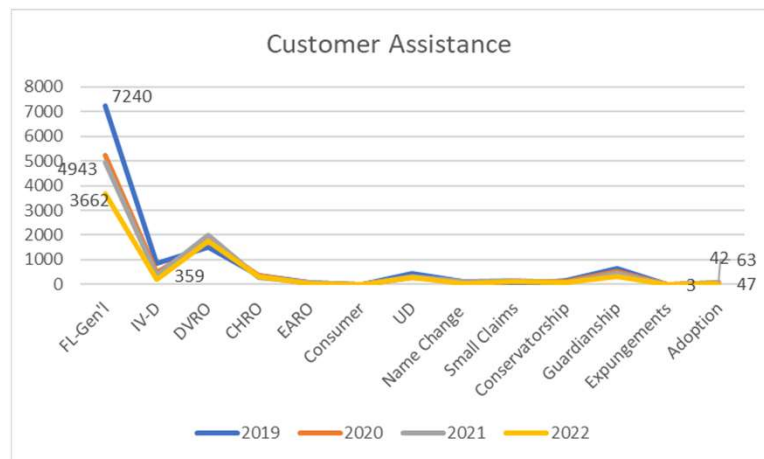

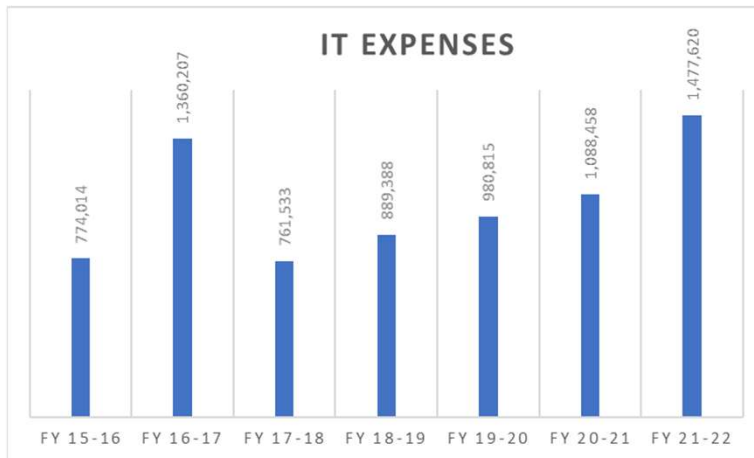

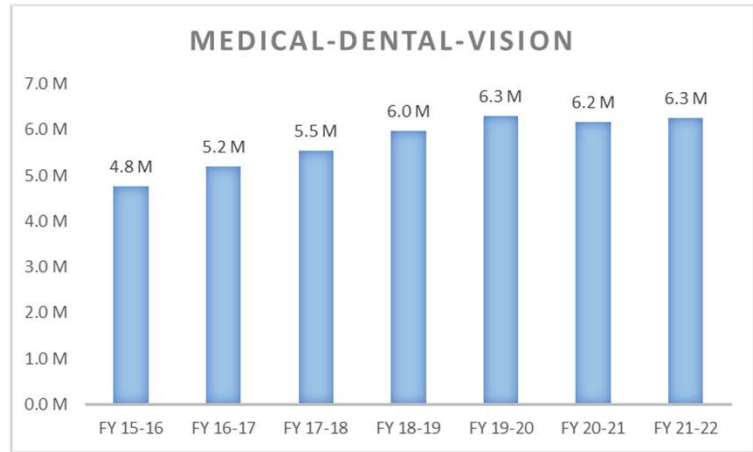

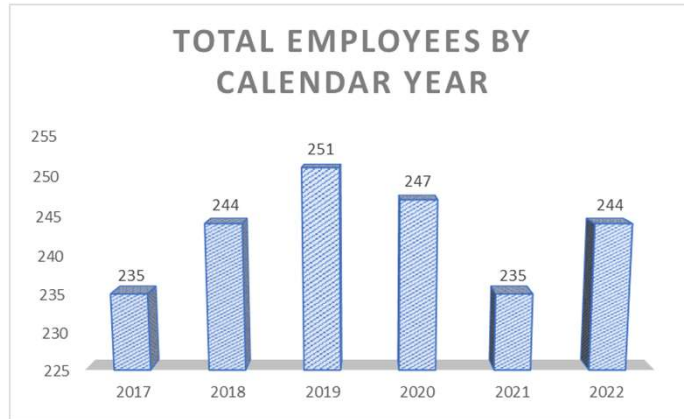

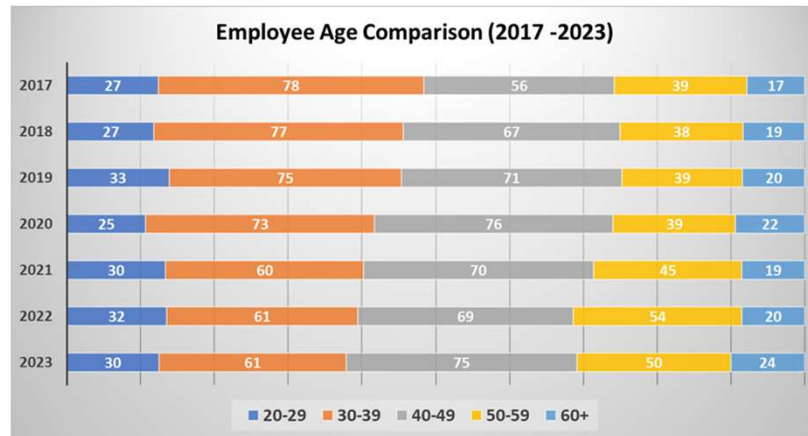

# Employee Age Comparison

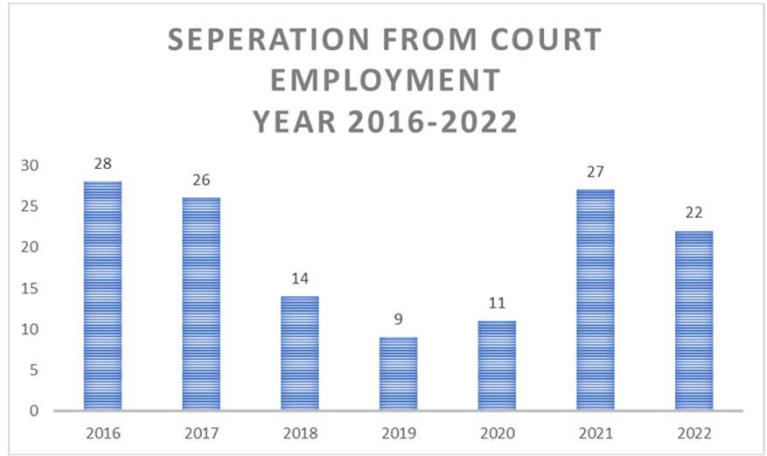

# Separation from Court Employment

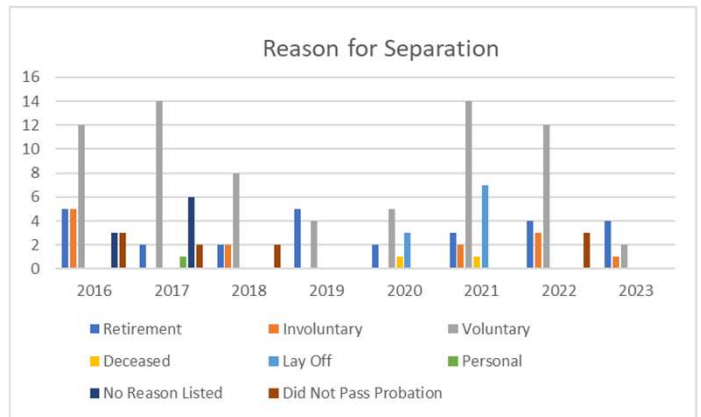

# Reason for Separation

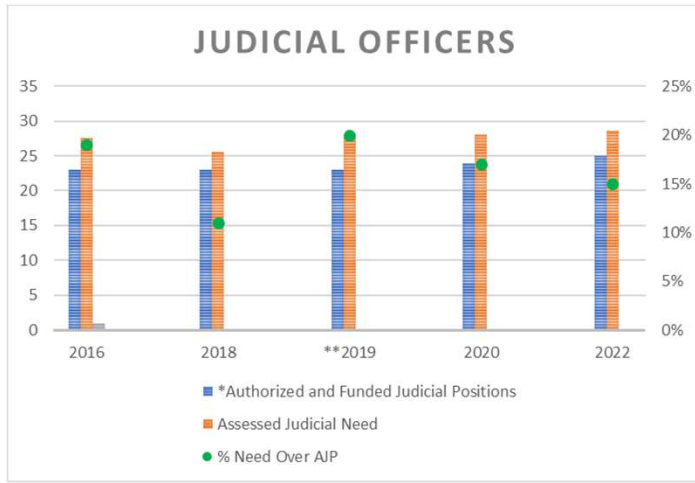

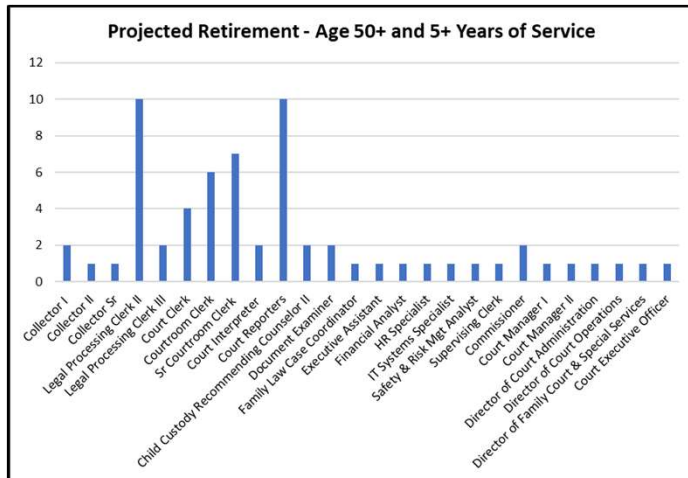

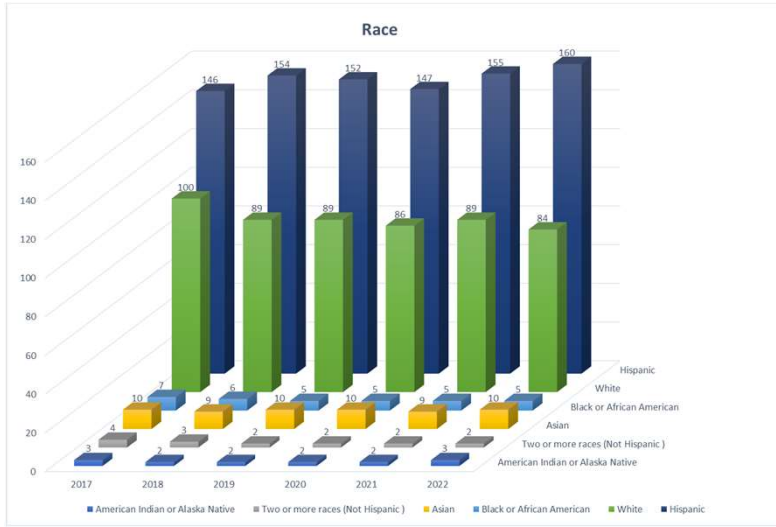

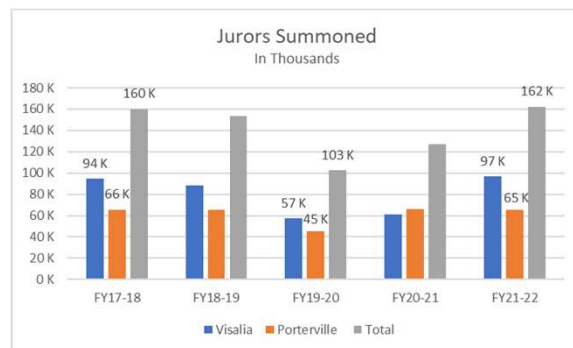

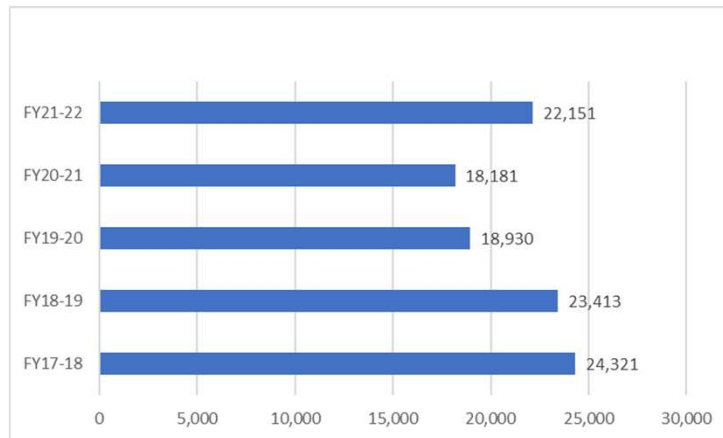

## Hearings Requiring Interpreter

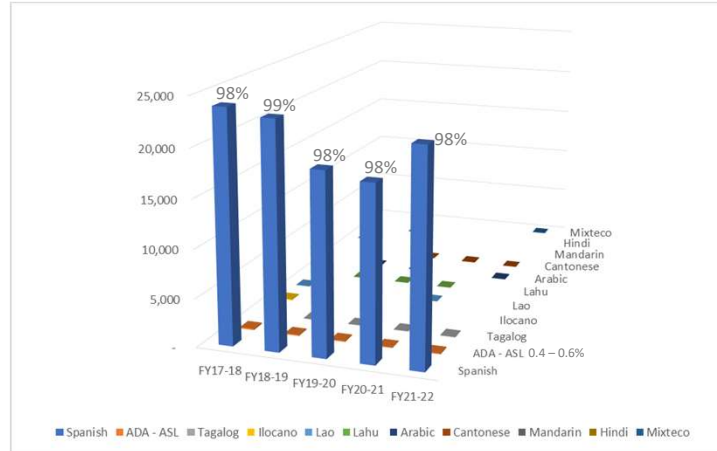
