TULARE COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT APPOINTS NATASHA MOISEYEV AS CHILD SUPPORT COMMISSIONER

The Tulare County Superior Court announced Natasha Moiseyev has been selected as Tulare County's newest Commissioner.

Commissioner Moiseyev was appointed after a recruitment last month. Moiseyev will preside over the court's AB1058 child support calendar and will be assigned to the Dinuba and Porterville divisions. "Natasha's years of service as the court's Family Law Facilitator makes her a natural selection for the commissioner position. Her family law background will be very beneficial in her new role. She is well respected and has established relationships with the Tulare County family law bench and the Department of Child Support Services. I am confident she will transition nicely to her new role and continue to serve the people of Tulare County in a new capacity." said Court Executive Officer, Stephanie Cameron.

Moiseyev has over nine years of public sector experience, most recently serving as the court's Family Law Facilitator. Moiseyev attended Yale earning a Bachelor of Art in Russian and East European Studies and earned her law degree at UC Davis. She is married to husband David and has two daughters.

Commissioners are subordinate judicial officers employed by the court to hear matters as assigned pursuant to statute or stipulation. Moiseyev fills a vacancy created by the recent retirement of Commissioner Norma Castellanos-Perez. This is a part time position and Moiseyev will earn \$137,548. annually.
